## Tezos Foundation Issues Grant to OCamlPro to Support TzScan

The Tezos Foundation is pleased to announce that it has issued a grant to [OCamlPro](#) to support its work on [TzScan](#), a block explorer for the Tezos blockchain that will be made open-source. OCamlPro is a French company and R&D lab focused on OCaml and blockchain development.

OCamlPro, which is an active community member and contributor to Tezos, has initiated several Tezos-related projects such as TzScan and [Liquidity](#), a high-level programming language for creating smart contracts in Tezos with an online editor, compiler, and debugger. Liquidity also features a decompiler to audit [Michelson](#) contracts.

Open-source block explorers are a key component of a blockchain ecosystem by allowing users to more easily monitor transactions, network validators (“bakers”), and the health of a network. OCamlPro will also provide documentation on Tezos and continue to improve the TzScan API, which may be used by applications such as wallets.

The Tezos Foundation’s core mission is to support the long-term success of the Tezos protocol and ecosystem. By funding projects imagined by scientists, researchers, developers, entrepreneurs, and enthusiasts, the Foundation encourages decentralized development and robust participation.
