Tezos Foundation Issues Grants to TezBridge and zednode

The Tezos Foundation is pleased to announce that it has issued grants to TezBridge and zednode.

[TezBridge](#) is a [tool](#) that allows users to interact with applications built on the Tezos blockchain. Built by [Catsigma](#), a Tezos developer, TezBridge works on both desktop and mobile web browsers and does not require a plug-in to be installed. With this grant, Catsigma will refine both the local and remote signers, refactor and audit the code, and improve the overall user experience of TezBridge.

Led by Ryan Loomba, the [zednode](#) team will build an open-source web dashboard to help Tezos bakers with accounting, rewards payouts, and other functions that may bring transparency and accountability to baking operations. Zednode is committed to helping grow the baking ecosystem with its free and open-source tools.
